3v3 World Cup Information & Rules

Event Information

Times

10:00am to 12:30pm – U9, U11, U13 Boys and Girls

Ethos for Event

The 3v3 event is meant to be a fun event for people of all abilities to celebrate the world's most popular sport. There is zero tolerance for unsportsmanlike behavior.

Player Eligibility

All players must be registered through the team registration page for the 3v3 tournament on the Saskatchewan Soccer website. Any player not registered as a part of the team will be unable to participate.

Game Duration

Games will be 15 minutes long with no extra time added to the game. The game-time is continuous without stoppages. Rock-Paper-Scissors will determine which team starts with the ball.

Game Rules (FIFA rules applied if not specified below)

- 1. Goals can be scored from anywhere on the field except for goal-kicks and kick-ins
- 2. There is no slide tackling allowed
- 3. Players who receive a red-card will be suspended for the rest of the tournament
- 4. There will be a 'goal area' marked by cones no player is allowed to stand in the goal area.
 - a. Should the ball stop moving inside the 'Goal Area' it will be restarted by the team that was defending as a Goal Kick





- b. If a defender stands inside the 'Goal Area' it will be a penalty shot for the attacking team as per the discretion of the referee
- c. If an attacker stands inside the 'Goal Area' the ball will be given to the defending team to restart the game
- 5. Required distance for all free kicks/kick-ins is 3 yards
- 6. Play can be restarted when the ball goes out of play with a pass or a dribble. The ball must be stationary before the player can pass or dribble the ball into the play
- 7. Kick-Off will be taken from the half-way point
- 8. Penalty Shots are taken from the half-way point towards the empty net
- 9. Substitutions will be on the fly meaning that the ball can be in play or out of play and substitutions can happen
 - a. If a team has too many players on the pitch (more than 3) the referee can call a penalty shot for the opposing team

Protests

Referee's decisions are final and no protests will be accepted by tournament organizers.
